Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka (Seventh Amendment), 2018.

Preamble

The Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka 2006 were notified in the Karnataka Gazette on 17th June, 2006. Subsequently, six amendments to the Conditions of Supply have been notified from time to time.

Whereas, the Additional Chief Secretary, Energy Department, Government of Karnataka and the BESCOM had requested the Commission to amend certain clauses of the CoS, which the Commission found acceptable. Consequently, the Commission found it necessary to make certain further amendments to the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka. The draft amendments (Seventh Amendment) were notified in the Karnataka State Gazette on 25.10.2018, vide Notification No: KERC/CoS/D/18-19, Bengaluru, Dated 04.10.2018. The draft were also hosted on the Commission's amendments www.karnataka.gov.in/kerc and a notification inviting objections / suggestions / views from the stakeholders was published in the newspapers for the information of public / interested persons, The Commission received, objections / suggestions / views from several stakeholders. The Commission also held a 'Public Hearing' on 19.11.2018 in the matter. The Commission has considered the objections / suggestions / views received from the stakeholders.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act No 36 of 2003) read with conditions 7.3 of the KERC (Conditions of License for ESCOMs) Regulations, 2004, clause 46 of the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka, and all the powers enabling it in that behalf, the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission, hereby makes the following amendments to the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of the Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka, 2006.

1. Title and commencement. -

- (a) This may be called as the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka (Seventh Amendment), 2018.
- b) It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette of the Karnataka State.
- (c) It shall apply to all the Licensees engaged in the business of distribution of electricity and the consumers of electricity in the State of Karnataka.

2. Amendment of certain clauses. -

In the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka, 2006, the existing Clauses mentioned in the Column – 2 of table below shall be substituted by the Clauses mentioned in the Column – 3. •
