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POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR ROOFTOP SOLAR PV PLANTS WITH NET METERING ARRANGEMENT

This Power Purchase Agreement is entered into at (place) Pandavapura, Mandya Dist, on this Day of January 2022 between Chamundeshwari Electricity Supply Corporation Limited (CESC), Mysuru, a Government of Karnataka undertaking, being a Company formed and incorporated in India under the Companies Act, 1956 with its registered office located at 29, Vijayanagar 2nd Stage, Hinkal, Mysuru-570017, Karnataka State,

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represented by A.E.E. O & M Sub Division, Pandavapura, Mandya Dist, hereinafter, referred to as the "CESC, Pandavapura", (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns), as party of the first part.

Shishu Abhivrudi Kendra, Melkote Grama Pamchayat, Pandavapura, Mandya Dist, the consumer of CESC, Pandavapura, hereinafter, referred to as the "Seller" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include his successors and permitted assigns), as party of the second part. Whereas,

- a. The Seller intends to connect and operate the Solar Roof Top Photo Voltaic (SRTPV) system with CESC Pandavapura HT/LT, Distribution system for sale of the Solar Power to CESC, Mandya, in terms of the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission's (KERC) Order No. S/03/01/62 dated: 18-08-2021.
- b. The Seller intends to install a SRTPV system of 2 kW capacity on the existing roof top of the premises, situated at Shishu Abhivrudi Kendra, Melkote Grama Pamchayat, Pandavapura, Mandya Dist, and bearing RR. No. MLK-14969. in the same premises, under Pandavapura Sub-Division of CESC, Pandavapura, Mandya / Mysore.
- c. The Seller intends to sell the energy, generated from the SRTPV system to CESC, Mandya / Mysore. on net-metering basis, from the date of commissioning of the SRTPV system. Explanation: The 'Commissioning' means the stage at which the SRTPV system starts generating the power for the use by the Seller and injects surplus power if any, into the grid.
- d. CESC, Mandya / Mysore intends to purchase the energy, generated by such SRTPV system, on netmetering basis, at the tariff determined by the KERC.

Now therefore, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties, hereto, intending to be legally bound, hereby, agree as under:

1. Technical and Interconnection Requirements:

Seller shall ensure his SRTPV system complies with the following, technical and interconnection requirements

- 1.1 Comply with the applicable standards and conditions, in respect of integrating the SRTPV system with the distribution system.
- 1.2 Connect and operate the SRTPV system to CESC's distribution system, in accordance with the State Grid Code, and Distribution Code as amended from time to time.
- 1.3 Install, prior to connection of SRTPV system to CESC's distribution system, an inverter with an automatic
- 1.4 Provide external manual isolation mechanism with suitable locking facility, so that SRTPV system will not back-feed into the CESC's network, in case of power outage of the CESC's Mandya / Mysore distribution system, and it shall be accessible for CESC, Mandya / Mysore to operate, if required, during maintenance/emergency conditions.
- 1.5 Install all the equipment of the SRTPV system, compliant with relevant International (IEEE/IEC) and Indian Standards (BIS).
- 1.6 (a) The SRTPV system shall be designed, engineered and constructed and operated by the seller or any other person on his behalf, with reasonable diligence, subject to all applicable Indian Laws, Rules, Regulations as amended from time to time and orders having the force of law. (b) The Seller, shall commission the SRTPV system, within six months from the date of approval of
- PPA. 1.7 Adhere to the following power quality measures, as per the International and Indian standards and/or such
- other measures, stipulated by the KERC/CESC, Mandya / Mysore. a. Harmonic current: Harmonic current injections from a generation unit shall not exceed the limits
 - specified in IEEE 519. b. Voltage at the injection point should be in the operating range of 80% to 1 10%, of the nominal connected voltage.

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The parties shall resolve the dispute in good faith and in equitable manner.

In case of failure to resolve the dispute, either of the parties may approach the appropriate Forum.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Seller and the CESC, Mysuru have entered into this Agreement to be executed as of the date and the year first set forth above.

- power generation and install Bi-directional meter (whole current/CI operation) interconnection to the distribution system, at a suitable place in the premises, accessible for recording export of energy, from the SRTPV system to the grid and import of energy to the premises of the consumer from the grid. The bi-directional meter, shall comply with the Central Electricity Authority (Installation and operation of meters) Regulations, 2006 and shall have the following features:
 - Separate registers, for recording export and import energy with facility to download by Meter i.
 - kVA, kW and kVAR measuring registers, for both import and export of energy.
 - The Meter, shall have RS232 (or higher) communication optical port / Radio Frequency (RF) port ii. to support Automatic Meter Reading (AMR). iii.
- 8.1 CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall issue monthly electricity bill for the net-energy on the scheduled date of
- 8.2 In case, the exported energy is more than the imported energy, the CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall pay for the net-energy exported, as per Tariff agreed in this agreement, within 30 days from the date of issue of bill,
- 8.3 In case, the exported energy is less than the imported energy, the Seller, shall pay CESC, Mandya / Mysore for the net-energy imported, as per the prevailing retail supply tariff, determined by the Commission from
- 8.4 The CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall pay interest at the same rates, as is being levied on the consumers, for late payment charges, in case of any delay in payment, beyond 30 (thirty) days period from the date of issue

Explanation: Net-energy means, the difference of meter readings of energy injected by the SRTPV system into the grid (export) and the energy drawn from the grid for use by the seller (import) recorded in the bi-directional meter.

- 9.1 This agreement, shall be in force for a period of 25 years from the date of commissioning of the SRTPV system, unless terminated otherwise, as provided here under.
- 9.2 If the CESC, Mandya / Mysore commits any breach of the terms of the Agreement, Seller shall serve a written notice specifying the breach and calling upon the CESC, Mandya / Mysore to remedy/ rectify the same, within 30 (thirty) days or at such other period and at the expiry of 30 (Thirty) days or such other period from the delivery of the notice, Seller may terminate the agreement by delivering the termination notice, if the CESC, Mandya / Mysore fails to remedy/ rectify the same.
- 9.3 If the Seller, commits any breach of the terms of the Agreement, the CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall serve a written notice specifying the breach and calling upon the seller to remedy/ rectify the same within 30 (thirty) days or at such other period and at the expiry of 30 (Thirty) days or such other period from the delivery of the notice, the CESC, Mandya / Mysore may terminate the agreement by delivering the termination notice, if the seller, fails to remedy/ rectify the same.
- 9.4 Upon termination of this Agreement, Seller shall cease to supply power to the distribution system and any injection of power shall not be paid for by the CESC, Mandya / Mysore.

10. Dispute Resolution: All the disputes, between the parties, arising out of or in connection with this agreement, shall be first tried to be settled through mutual negotiation.

2. Safety:

The Seller, shall comply with the following safety measures:

2.1 The Seller shall comply with the Central Electricity Authority (Measures Relating to Safety and Electric

2.2 The Seller shall ensure that, the design; installation; maintenance, and operation of the SRTPV system, Supply) Regulations, 2010. in a manner, conducive to the safety of the SRTPV system, as well as, the CESC's Mandya / Mys distribution system.

2.3 If the Seller's SRTPV system either, causes damage to and/or produces adverse effects on the or consumers' or CESC's Mandya / Mysore assets, Seller will disconnect SRTPV system immediately, fr the distribution system, by himself or upon directions from the CESC, Mandya / Mysore and rectify same at his own cost before reconnection.

3. Clearances and Approvals:

The Seller, shall obtain CESC's Mandya / Mysore and other statutory approvals and clearances, bet connecting the SRTPV system to the distribution system.

4. Access and Disconnection

- 4.1 CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall have access to metering equipment and disconnecting device of SRT system, both automatic and manual, at all times.
- 4.2 In emergency or outage situation, where there is no access to a disconnecting device either, automatic manual, the CESC, Mandya / Mysore shall have the right to disconnect power supply to the premises.

5. Liabilities

The Seller, shall be solely responsible for availing any fiscal or other incentive, provided by the State/ Cen government at his own expenses.

Commercial Settlement

6.1 Tariff:

- a. The CESC Mandya / Mysore shall pay for the Net energy at Rs. 3.19 per kWh, as determined by the KE in the Order dated 18-08-2021 for the term of this agreement.
- b. If for any reason the date of commissioning is delayed, beyond the date of commissioning agreed, the ta payable by the CESC Mandya / Mysore, shall be lower of the:
 - Tariff agreed to in this agreement.


